Below is an example of groundrules for a workshop on team effectiveness, to be discussed and signed by each participant at the beginning of the workshop:

We the undersigned pledge to honour the following groundrules in our work together in this workshop on team building:

- 1. We are all here to learn more about how to be effective together as a team, and we will each work to create an environment conducive to learning.
- 2. We want a constructive and useful outcome to this workshop and will work together to achieve that.
- 3. We will each accord respect to the experiences, needs, and priorities of each participant and expect respect in return.
- 4. We will do our best to be honest and forthcoming in our participation.
- 5. We will do our best to avoid using derogatory or judgmental language when commenting on the contribution of another participant.
- 6. We will do our best to avoid using humour (especially sarcasm) in a manner that belittles another participant.
- 7. We will express any issues or concerns we have about the workshop content or process to the group rather than keeping silent or only talking to others on breaks.
- 8. We will treat the personal feelings expressed by others in the workshop in confidence
- 9. We will be conscientious in practicing each of the key team skills as requested in the workshop.
- 10. We will take responsibility for signalling to each other if and when we believe that we are behaving in ways that are not consistent with these groundrules.
- 11. We will honor any action commitments that we make in the workshop.
